- 1921 2M people unemployed
War debt at \$40 B
- 1922 - Labour Party -
"evolutionary socialism"
- 1924 - Conservative Party
dole - 5 years +
100.7 thousands of
workers unemployed
- 1926 - General Strike
- 1928 - 20-30% of workers
on dole
- 1929 - Labour Party
Mass unemployment
cut
wages
- 1937 - Neville Chamberlain - Prime
Minister
→ "peace quiet" - English feel
"flirting of fascism"

France - 1920s-1930s

- WWI - 1M Frenchmen dead
mainly younger than 24
12,000 sq. miles - was
a war zone
- By 1923 - inflation (equal
to Germany)
- By 1930 - Rising unemployment
Budget deficits
Budget going to
redoubant
- 1924 Corruption unstoped
& citizens storming
Chamber of Deputies
- 1936 - sitdown strike - MANU

↳ collective bargaining
↳ Public work program
- 1937 - ending deficits,
Conservatives in power
strike suppression
