- ① Some were slaves (lifetime), some were servants (less than lifetime).
- ② Servants got land at the end of service.
- ③ Colonial laws stopped Africans or African Americans (those born in the colonies) from being servants. Also passed "slave codes" spread to other colonies. PA & MD "slave codes" spread to other colonies.
- ④ At end of service, there was no land so these people became "landless freemen".
- ⑤ Planters stopped importing English servants and started buying African slaves.
- ⑥ Protects slave owners/master of indentured servants if they runaway. Counts 3/5 of slaves for representation & taxes.

Orange = Slave owners could not have a chance for newland
 Pink = Black freemen & later freedmen have a chance for newland
 green = Black " " " " " to vote
 yellow = whites representation in House & Electoral College determined by counting 3/5 of slaves + later 3/5 of Blacks
