corollary

a proposition ... inferred immediately from a proved proposition with little or no additional proof

foreign policy

the policy of a sovereign state in its interaction with other sovereign states

global

"of, relating to, or involving the entire world"

international

active, known, or reaching beyond national boundaries

neighbor

one living or located near another **Caution:** Think about the word *neighbor*.

protectorate

the dependent political unit or territory in such a relationship

quasi

having some resemblance usually by possession of certain attributes a *quasi* corporation
