


# Comparing Colonies in the Sections on the Events

1600-1630s	Religion - Calvinist, one Big DEAL - Theocracy Type - charter Workers - themselves/their kids land - small/middle Assembly - male elect vote		Religion - Anglican BUT NOT a Big deal Type - charter Workers - servants (English & Black) & slave & themselves land - large (headright) Assembly - land owners vote
1630s-1650s	Splintering of colony - move out (2 to Connecticut) - forced out - Williams to Rhode Island - followers of Hutchinson to New Hampshire	Maryland - Catholic - haven - economy - like VA - feudalism in theory Mercantilist Shift AFTER 1660	Va - more people 5X - some landless By 1640s & unnecessary
1650s+	Land not enough - Faith " (1/2 way covenant) 1670s Indian/white 1690s witchcraft trial	New York - patroonships (feudalism) - no assembly (just Council) Pennsylvania - Religion - Quaker never BUT OPEN TO ALL - Proprietary Delaware New Jersey	Carolinas 1600s Slavery model first Barbados Georgia (1730s) - Proprietary to trustees 1670s Indian rebellion 1690s Indian/white
