

Reply to This Email (This is a required graded assignment.) To do this **graded** assignment, do these steps.

1. Click Reply.
2. Look for the yellow underlining like this: .
3. Type the answer in the yellow underlining. (In some cases the answer is just an X.)
4. Make sure your answers are right. Proof your work--an essential Life/Work Habit.

Emergency Contact Information – I do not require you to do this, but it is safer for you.

What Grade to You Plan to Earn? I do require you to answer this.

The List of Due Dates shows you **what's due when** and it shows **where** you can find the assignment. It also shows you:

- On the left, a gray checkbox (on the left) of every grade you need to earn in the course so you have a "reminder" of what you have to do. **Tips:** If you want an A or even a B, you want to do your best on **every** assignment. (Sometimes doing your best means asking your prof for help and I am fine with that.)
- On the right, the points for that graded assignment. **Tips:** Make sure the total points for what you will do adds up to the number of points you need. Remember most of us are not perfect on every assignment.

Place an **X** to the left of **YOUR planned grade** in this 1000-point course. Notice the difference in an A for 895 points and 894 points. You **must** have a 5 (not a 4) in the last digit to get the higher grade.
