

1. Carefully do what I did when I graded your paper. That means you open your textbook to the page you were using for your facts and compare that with your words and with my comments.

I understand that you will use the same methods and rubric for grading with the next Comparisons.

I understand you will be glad to talk to me about the feedback and how to prevent these problems.

Here are some things that are different from what I said I would do in the syllabus:

- There is an error in the rubric that is current attached to the Introductory, Practice Comparison and the Unit 1 Comparison. It means that you get **more** points than you would have gotten for the comparisons. I will fix it by Unit 2 Comparison.
- Given the time, I am not following the rule in the syllabus on page 8. I am not requiring you to do those extra instructions to be able to see the next Comparison.
