

## Finger tips as the Trick for Good Pictures of Photo IDs Plus Tips for Vertical

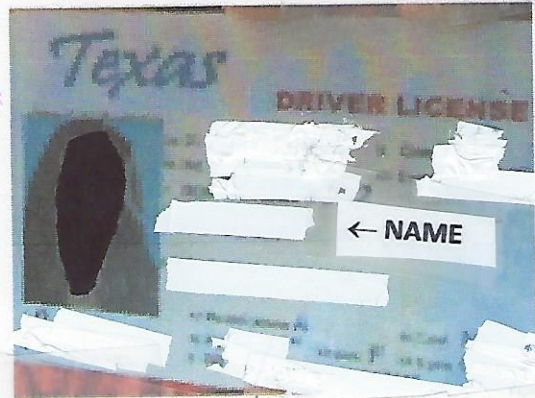
You are required to make these 2 things visible because the prof is required to:

- Compare your face on the photo you take with Respondus with your Photo ID so your picture must be clear
- Compare your name in the course with your name on your ID so your Printed name must be readable to the prof

How do you do it? The students who did it held the Photo ID with their fingertips and placed it next to the WebCam and checked what they saw when they did it. See below for what I mean about the fingertips.

## If you have a Vertical Texas Photo ID

For my class—and other profs may differ—I need to see your face and your Printed name:

- I am fine with your **not** showing **all** of a vertical Texas Photo ID as long as your face and Printed name are clear.
- I am **not** fine with your turning your vertical license horizontally so I have to stop and make a paper print so I can compare.

Other teachers may not agree, but this is fine with me. Notice that this student showed her photo and her READABLE name but left off:



- part of the top (such as the word Texas)
- part of the bottom
