

## Estimating Your Current Letter Grade -Total=900 points After Final Exam Is Entered

At My Grades, notice your **Total** at the bottom. **Caution:** Do **not** use the stuff at the bottom of My Grades with the /.

The yellow below is not high tech. An A is 90%; B, 80%; C, 70%; and D, 60% so you see the math on the left. On the right, the letter you have earned thus far. **Example:** if your Total at the bottom of My Grades says 640 points, you have a B right now. **To see points after the Final is entered, look at the yellow at the bottom.**

For this term only 900 points:

Example: An A is 90% of 900=810. If you had a grade of 805 I would round it up to an A. If it was 804, I would not.

Point Range	Final Letter Grade
805 – 900	A (exceptional)
715– 804	B (above average)
625 – 714	C (average)
535 – 624	D (below average)
Below 535.	F (failing)

Note: This was the equivalent functioning on a 1000 point course so you can see it for yourself.

Example: if you had a grade of 89.5, I would round it up to an A. If it was 894, I would not.

Point Range	Final Letter Grade
895 – 1000	A (exceptional)
795 – 894	B (above average)
695 – 794	C (average)
595 – 694	D (below average)
Below 595	F (failing)
