

## How to Determine Your Current Letter Grade Through Unit 2

At My Grades, notice your **Total** at the bottom. **Caution:** Do **not** worry about the number at the bottom with the **/**.

The yellow below is not high tech. An A is 90%; B, 80%; C, 70%; and D, 60% so you see the math on the left. On the right, the letter you have earned thus far.

**Example:** if your Total at the bottom of My Grades says **401** points after your exam and the grading of Ask/Answer/Share, you have a B right now.

0.9 X 502 = 451	so 451 or more and you have an	A-
0.8 X 502 = 401	so 401 or more and you have a	B-
0.7 X 502 = 351	so 351 or more and you have a	C-
0.6 X 502 = 301	so 301 or more and you have a	D-
	Less than 301	F
