A: Grants Peace Policy and The Dawes Act.

Grants peace policy stated that the government would send christians in to their land and try to humanely teach and change the indian culture and assimilate the indians into white culture. - If the indians rebelled against the christians, then the military would intervene. The Dawes severality act gave indians 160-acres of land to live on, and they were not allowed to sell or lease it for 25 years. The indians could choose to change to fit in with white culture or not to, but ANY extra land was sold to WHITE FARMERS.
