

This Peer Review is worth 30 points for each of the review. With the whole 60-point assignment, an A is 54 or above; a B is 48 or above, a C is 42 or above, a D is 36 and an F is below 36. The letter scale for each review has these criteria:

A = Very useful to the other student, showed extensive knowledge of history, and detailed and through, with specific examples.

B = Somewhat useful to the other student, showed good knowledge of history, and provided some details and comments.

C = Intended to be useful, but too vague for the student to guess which statement applied to which part of the student's work, showed no specific knowledge of history, and provided few clues to what of the reviewer's comments applied to which place in the student's work.

D = Repetitive responses to all questions. Did not catch obvious errors of fact or "half-copy" plagiarism. (Compare the paper with the textbook; you will!)

F = Answered with only the word "yes" or "no." Alternatively, provided vague statements applicable to any paper.
